1. Explore the Rapanui 'Artefacts' map

Requirements: access to EarthMuseum Learn digital history explorer map

Working style: individually or in pairs

Curriculum: Geography; History; Citizenship; Computing (using online resources)

Time: 20 minutes

Access the [EarthMuseum Learn digital history explorer map](#), and select Rapanui (Artefacts) from the Learning Programme drop-down list.

Teacher Note: See [Teacher Introduction](#) film for guidance about how to use the map before learning activity begins.

This will select stories about artefacts taken from Rapa Nui (Easter Island) and now housed in museums across the world. These artefacts have been plotted on the map in the places where they originally came from on the Island.
