The Belize coral reef system became a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1996. **Fragments of Hope** registered in 2013 as a not-for-profit community-based organisation. Based in Placencia Village in Belize, Fragments of Hope focuses mainly on restoring the Belize coral reefs and advocacy for the sustainable management of its habitats.

Fragments of Hope works with the local community in Belize to raise awareness of the ecology and environment of the marine and related ecosystems and provide education to local Belizeans to support them in protecting and preserving the coral reef system. It helps find alternative livelihoods to relieve stress or threats to the marine environment and related ecosystems.
